More Thoughts on SALT

The Spiritual Activist Leadership Training (SALT) offers an amazing experience for young adults who are looking to deepen their understanding of Unitarian Universalism, get to know California's justice history and issues, develop justice oriented leadership skills and make connections with inspiring faith and justice leaders throughout California. The 10 month part-time program involves significant travel in California and even to Mexico, but can be accomplished while working or in school. Those who are selected to participate receive a \$2000 subsidy to cover their travel expenses and are expected to raise \$500 during the program as part of their leadership training.

We are proud of this year's SALT Fellows who will graduate in a ceremony after the morning worship at General Assembly with the Rev. Rebecca Parker, President of Starr King School of the Ministry, speaking.

Sometimes it takes an invitation from someone else to see leadership potential in yourself.
