CHILDREN'S RELIGIOUS EXPLORATION (CRE) COMMITTEE CHARGE
Adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 8, 2016

Purpose

The CRE Committee shall oversee ongoing CRE programming, ensuring, together with the Assistant Minister for Congregational Life and the Religious Exploration Coordinator that these activities are well coordinated and implemented.

Responsibilities

- To provide Religious Exploration (RE) leadership.
- To recruit and assist with training or other support needed for volunteer teachers.
- To provide input to curriculum and Bridgehouse operations.
- To plan community-building activities.
- To work with the Board and congregation to ensure support and approval of the RE structure and programs.

Goal

The goal of the CRE Committee shall be to provide a warm, welcoming, and healthy atmosphere for children and families, building community through RE activities and programs.

Special Qualities or Skills Needed By Members

Portfolios or areas of interest include: chair, recruitment, family ministry, social-service Sundays, curriculum, and special events.

Number of Members Needed

6 to 8 members.

Terms of Office

Chair: 1 year. Members: 3 years.

Membership Selection Process

Members are typically recruited by sitting Committee members in collaboration with the Assistant Minister for Congregational Life and the RE Coordinator.
