CHILDREN & YOUTH RELIGIOUS EXPLORATION (CYRE)
COUNCIL CHARGE

Adopted by the Board of Trustees on November 12, 2012

Purpose

The CYRE Council shall oversee ongoing CYRE programming, ensuring, together with the Director Lifespan Learning & Religious Exploration (DLL) and the Youth Director, that these activities are well coordinated and implemented.

Responsibilities

- To provide Religious Exploration (RE) leadership.
- To determine training or other support needed for volunteer teachers and staff.
- To provide input to and revision of curriculum.
- To plan special worship and community-building activities.
- To work with the Board and congregation to ensure support and approval of the RE structure and programs.
- To collaborate with the DLL in implementing the Church's Children & Youth Religious Exploration Safety Policy.

Goals

The goal of the CYRE Council shall be to provide a warm, welcoming, and healthy atmosphere for children and families, building community through RE activities and programs.

Special Qualities or Skills Needed By Members

Portfolios or areas of interest include: teacher recruitment, family ministry, social-service Sundays, and special events.

Number of Members Needed

6 to 8 members.

Terms of Office

Chair: 1 year. Members: 3 years.

Membership Selection Process

Members are typically recruited by sitting Council members in collaboration with the Director of Lifespan Learning & Religious Exploration.
