**CAMPUS MINISTRY COMMITTEE CHARGE**

**Purpose**

Unitarian Universalism offers an important and often missing religious alternative on college campuses and in communities at large. We have a moral imperative to be present and visible. Students, both UU-identified and those who have yet to know of us, need a place where they can be accepted as they are, with their varying identities and all their questions about faith, love, and life. The mission of the Campus Ministry Committee is to nurture and support a UU ministry to college students in our community.

**Responsibilities**

- To provide a space for faith development and pastoral support for students on local campuses and connect them with the ministry and members of our congregation.
- To provide a liaison to the Internship Committee when an intern is serving as our campus minister.
- To supply meals for student meetings as possible.

**Goals**

- To provide ministry to college students as part of “welcoming each and all, cultivating the spirit” (UUCD Mission Statement).
- To provide a UU presence in Davis for college students.

**Special Qualities or Skills Needed by Members**

- Interest in and commitment to college students.
- Willingness to help provide meals for meetings or to help with activities.
- Student representative.

**Number of Members Needed**

Five to nine, including student member(s). The Campus Minister is an automatic member.

**Terms of Office**

Chair: 1 year. Member: 3 years. Student member: 1 year.

Volunteer.
