## **COCO RANCH** (Davis)

Coco Ranch, located on Putah Creek between Davis and Winters, grows and sells nutrient-dense, certified-organic, fresh tree fruit. The ranch specializes in cherries (May-June) and apples (August-November). Fruit is available for pick-up at the farm's downtown Davis Workshop in season on Thursdays from 4-7pm. Ethnobotanical information on local wild plants and nutrient-dense food offered at the Workshop make your food pick-up doubly worth your while. Call or email Coco to place your order.

## **DEL RIO BOTANICAL** (West Sacramento)

The Del Rio Botanical, located on Old River Road between Sacramento and Woodland, offers gourmet fresh local and seasonal produce boxes delivered to Davis and other cities for twenty dollars per week, paid quarterly. Quarters begin on January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1. CSA deliveries may begin at any time, with the quarter prorated. They also offer dinner and tour programs and farming classes.

## **EATWELL FARM** (Dixon)

Eatwell Farm's 70 acres are located at Pedrick and I-80. The farm grows numerous crops for farmers' markets and CSA produce basket programs. A 4-box introductory subscription costs \$92. A 13 box share costs \$276, and a 26 box share \$552. Each Alternate week baskets are available and eggs may be ordered as well. They have various pick-up sites in the region. This second generation family farm is 100% certified organic. They farm year round and always have a large variety of fresh produce including stone fruit and grapes in the summer and chard and leeks in the winter. They sell wholesale, at farmer's markets, and provide CSAs that are delivered to your door or office. Boxes cost \$31.50/week.

## **FULL BELLY FARM** (Guinda)

Full Belly Farm, growing a wide variety of fruits, vegetables, flowers, nuts and livestock,, has been certified organic since 1985 and has operated a CSA program since 1992. Full Belly offers boxes year-round with a three-week break at the end of the year. The box cost is \$17/week with discounts for long-term payments. They provide Wednesday and Saturday deliveries in Sacramento, Davis, and Woodland.

## **GOOD HUMUS PRODUCE** (Capay)

Good Humus Produce has been growing and marketing organic vegetables, fruits, herbs, and flowers in the Sacramento Valley since 1976. They sell their produce at the Davis Farmer's Market every Wednesday and Saturday all year round. They also offer a weekly CSA with pick-up spots in Davis, Woodland, Sacramento, and Roseville. A subscription share price is \$200 for a 12-week quarter. Also, they offer a fruit only subscription for \$175/quarter and a flower bouquet subscription for \$72/quarter.

Riverdog Farm provides freshly picked organic produce through a CSA program, wholesale outlets, and at the Berkeley Farmers' Markets. Members pick up their shares year round at drop sites in Davis, Sacramento, Woodland, and other cities in Napa Valley and the Bay area. Davis, Sacramento, and Woodland pick-up times are between 3 and 7 PM on Fridays. A subscription share price is \$20/week to be paid monthly, quarterly, or annually in advance of deliveries. Half-shares are not available.

**TERRA FIRMA FARM** (Winters)

Terra Firma Farm serves the best restaurants in San Francisco and CSA members in 36 local neighborhoods include Davis, Sacramento, Winters, Vacaville, and the Bay area. They offer a choice of box sizes of Certified Organic produce, which is delivered weekly except for two weeks in late December-early January. A small box is \$59/month and \$170/quarter. A medium box is \$98/month and \$282/quarter. Large boxes are \$132/month, and \$380/quarter. Deliveries are Fridays in Sacramento and Davis, and Wednesday in Vacaville and Winters.
