Imagine... UUCD Stewardship 2023



We have spent this church year remembering where we've come from and re-imagining the future, so the Stewardship team decided that *Imagine*... would be an apt theme for this year's Annual Giving Drive. (Which turns my mind to the song, "<u>Imagine</u>," and from there it shifts to "<u>If I Had \$1,000,000</u>," and imagine if we had that in our budget!)

The stewardship campaign is our annual opportunity to align our money with our values as we practice generosity. In a more practical vein, we make a pledge, a commitment of our giving, and our Board of Trustees uses that information to build a budget that enables us to live our mission, vision, and values together in our church community.

This year the Board of Trustees has asked the Stewardship team to collect an additional \$30,000 in pledges over last year's total which is about a 6% increase across the board. That's about \$180 per current pledge - only \$15 more per month if each of us were able to increase our giving. I know that not all of us are able to increase our pledge, but it's also probably true that some of us could increase a bit more, so it might average out.

Much of this increase is to ensure just and equitable wages, and annual cost of living increases, for our staff. Our compensation policies and practices are a way of living our values and an opportunity to promote equity, transparency, and economic justice. Our staff works hard to support our church community and its programs, and they should be paid fairly for their labor.

Some staff we see regularly, on Sunday mornings, and others perform jobs that are more behind the scenes and not necessarily on Sundays. All together, these are the folks who bring us worship and music and lifespan learning, who take care of our littlest ones and guide our children, support our programs such as Deep Listening groups and the Justice teams. They help us help ourselves by providing support for the grounds work parties and the Caring Council. Your pledge will sustain our efforts to fulfill our mission and vision.

Always, there was consensus. To this day, I offer 10% of my income to my community. Imagine the impact UUCD could have in our world if we moved toward a tithe of 10%.
