- Keep a Loving Distance of 6'
 We help everyone feel safe
- Share the Opportunity to Gather
 We take our turn if there's limited enrollment for an event,
 allowing others to RSVP if we have attended an event recently
- Greet & Care Creatively
 We use new physical expressions of greeting and caring, and we use kind gestures to indicate "I don't feel safe"
- Practice Kind Honesty & Compassion
 We respond with compassion, we are gentle with each other,
 and take responsibility of our actions

This is a living document that will change as we have more information over time. With the guidance of this covenant, it is the responsibility of everyone to create a community of trust where all people can feel safe.
